**Subject: In the matter of Determination of Ad-hoc Tariff for International Cargo Handling Services by M/s RSICL at Jaipur International Airport.**

**Submission of the Independent Service Provider:**

1. The Rajasthan Small Industries Corporation Ltd. (RSICL), a Rajasthan State Government Undertaking, has been operating an Air Cargo Complex at Jaipur International Airport as an Independent Service Provider (ISP) since 1979, under the Customs custodianship, facilitating EXIM trade of the State of Rajasthan.
2. The ISP, vide email dated 30.12.2025 informed that after the handing over of operations and management of Jaipur International Airport by the Airports Authority of India (AAI) to Jaipur International Airport Limited (JIAL) in October, 2020, the new airports operator



JIAL declined to extend the existing agreement between AAICLAS and RSICL. M/s JIAL issued notices to RSICL for vacation of the existing Air Cargo premises operated by it at Jaipur Airport.

3. In order to ensure continuity of international air cargo operations at Jaipur Airport by RSICL, the Management of RSICL entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with AAICLAS on a revenue-sharing basis on 10.05.2024, whereby RSICL took over the international cargo operations and Regulated Agent (RA) functions in respect of AAICLAS Air cargo complex at Jaipur Airport. The Agreement shall be effective for an initial period of 3 years from the date of handing over/ taking over of the premise which shall be further extended for another 3 years on mutual agreement.
4. The ISP conveyed that prior to execution of MOU with AAICLAS they were only providing the Cargo Handling Service pertaining to Freight Forwarders Agents. However, subsequent to signing of aforesaid MOU, they are functioning as Regulated Agents and providing Cargo Handling Service related to Airlines also.
5. The tariff for international cargo handling services earlier approved by AERA in favour of RSICL covers the services related to Exporters/Importers only and it does not include tariff for services related to Airlines.
6. M/s RSICL vide letter dated 30.12.2025 requested the Authority to approve the ad-hoc tariff proposed by it in respect of cargo services pertaining to Airlines, for the period i.e. up to 31.03.2026, till the determination of regular tariff.

#### **Authority's Examination**

7. The Authority, vide Order No. 29/2018-19 dated 16.11.2018 had approved the regular tariff for RSICL in respect of International Cargo Handling Service related to Freight Forwarder Agents/ Exporters & Importers at Jaipur Airport, for the Second Control Period (01.04.2016 - 31.03.2021), initially for the period up to 31.03.2019 as the concession agreement of RSICL was valid up to 31.03.2019. However, in the same order the Authority stated that the tariff shall be applicable up to 31.03.2021, in case, the Concession Agreement was extended beyond 31.03.2019.

The validity of tariff (prevailing as on 31.03.2019) applicable to the ISP has been extended on interim basis, from time to time, as RSICL was operating at Jaipur Airport as an ad-hoc arrangement with Airport Operator, after the expiry of its regular concession agreement with AAI/AAICLAS. The present interim extension of Tariff for RSICL is valid up to 31.03.2026.

8. The Authority notes that AAICLAS appointed M/s RSICL as a new cargo handling agency for handling its international cargo operations at Jaipur International Airport. RSICL and AAICLAS entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) dated 10.05.2024 on a revenue-sharing basis. Pursuant to the aforesaid MoU, RSICL took over the International Cargo Operations of AAICLAS at Jaipur International Airport and is functioning as Regulated Agent (RA) from the AAICLAS premises.



It is noted that RSICL has been handed over only the “International Cargo Handling Operations” by AAICLAS, Whereas, AAICLAS continues to provide the domestic cargo handling services at Jaipur International Airport.

9. The ISP has submitted the following documents along with its request for approval of ad-hoc tariff in respect of international cargo handling services at Jaipur International Airport.
  - (i) Copy of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between AAICLAS and RSIC dated 10.05.2024;
  - (ii) Letter of BCAS dated 16.09.2025 conveying the Approval of Security Programme of M/s RSIC and registration of RSICL as a Regulated Agent (RA) at Jaipur International Airport. It is noted that the Security Programme is valid for a period of five years, effective from date of issue.
10. The Authority observed that the ISP had not provided any concessional TSP charges for AFS cargo. In response to query raised by AERA on the issue, the ISP vide email 15.01.2026, has informed that a minimum of 30% concession in the approved tariff in respect of TSP charges for Air Freight Station (AFS) shall be applicable on the proposed tariff at Air Cargo Complex (RAJSICO), Jaipur.
11. Considering that subsequent to execution of MoU between RSICL & AAICLAS, RSICL has taken over the International Cargo Handling operations of AAICLAS at Jaipur Airport and ISP has proposed the same tariff which was earlier approved by AERA for AAICLAS International Cargo Handling Service at Jaipur International Airport, the Authority decides to consider the Ad-hoc tariff as submitted by the ISP, for the period up to 31.03.2026.

### Order

Upon careful consideration of the material available on record, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) M/s RSICL is allowed to levy & collect, on ad hoc basis, the Tariff for International Cargo Handling Services at Jaipur International Airport, (as per **Annexure-I**), effective from date of issue of order up to 31.03.2026, or, till the determination of regular tariff for the RSICL, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) Tariff approved, as above, shall be the maximum charges to be levied to the Users and no other charge(s) is to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.
- (iii) The Tariff approved as above is excluding of all the applicable taxes.
- (iv) The Airport Operator, shall publish this approved Tariff in respect of international cargo handling Services to be provided by RSICL at Jaipur International Airport, at its official website for the information of all Stakeholders.



- (v) ISP shall submit the MYTP within two months from the date of issuance of this Order.
- (vi) The Airport Operator shall ensure compliance of this Order.

**Ad hoc Tariff Approved by AERA for International Cargo Handling Services rendered by RSICL to Airlines at Jaipur International Airport, Jaipur, effective from the date of issue of the order till 31.03.2026.**

**NOTES:**

- a) Demurrage charges on Import Transshipment cargo will be same as applicable to Import Cargo except that no handling charges shall be levied on the airlines handled by RSICL where the TP Cargo handed over to the airlines on airside designated area on the airport. 50% discount will be applicable only on TSP/handling charges where the import transshipment cargo moved in ULD form to the other Airports of RSICL by road. In



both the cases, subject to payment of minimum charges as applicable in respective category.

- b) Demurrage charges on transshipment cargo from Domestic to International and from International to International shall be treated as same as applicable for export cargo, after allowing the normal free period and subject to payment of minimum applicable export demurrage charges.
- c) The free period for export cargo for the carrier from the time of entry in bonded area till upliftment shall be 36 hrs. as per Government Directives as of now.
- d) No free period may be allowed on second time handling/upliftment of export cargo from cargo terminal, Applicable charges (Demurrage/Storage) shall be levied.
- e) In case of Transit ULDs brought by the Airlines handed over to RSICL for Storage in the Bonded Area/ETV stacker for any reasons, the storage charges as given at Serial 1 and 2 of the tariff rate card shall be levied.
- f) The free period for export cargo for the NSOs in the bonded area, would be same as applicable for scheduled carrier as per the government regulations issued from time to time, from the time of physical acceptance at bonded area.
- g) XBIS usage charges INR. 1.00 per kg subject to minimum of INR 150.00 per shipment at Export. The same is applicable at 50% per kg subject to minimum of INR 100.00 per ODC shipment where physical check with the help of ETDs are facilitated. However, in random check cases in ETDs by Airlines after scanning through XBIS, no charges to be levied for usage or ETDs. X-Ray Certification Charges: INR 1.50 per kg, subject to a minimum of INR 150.00 per shipment.
- h) Charges shall be leviable separately for installation/commissioning/ maintenance of Air Cargo Inspection System (ACIS) as stipulated by CBIC as & when implemented.
- i) Additional Packing services required by Airlines for any shipment shall be additionally chargeable.
- j) All the Scheduled Airlines shall maintain Security deposit for adequate amount as prescribed by RSICL for the cargo operations a part from the security deposit for License fee and enter into an agreement for availing credit facility as per the policy prescribed from time to time.
- k) Any other agencies operating at airport utilizing RSICL equipment like Forklift, Tractor and any other equipment shall be charged separately.
- l) All minimum charges shall be rounded off to the nearest Rupee 1.00.
- m) All Bills shall be rounded up to the nearest higher of Rupee 1.00.
- n) The above charges are excluding GST, which will be charged at extra applicable rates.
- o) For Cargo Logistics/Handling pertaining to Air Freight Station (AFS), 30% lower Terminal, Storage and Processing Charges shall be applicable.
